

### February 8, 2021 - District Alignment Update

Dear Virginia Annual Conference:

Peace to you as we continue in this season of pandemic and challenge. The world, in fact, seems quite changed in recent years, something we have felt for some time as a conference. Thankfully, we serve a god who is unchanging, unfailing and unending.

As Virginia United Methodists, we have met this moment in our history with renewed vision, setting our eyes on the One who is unfailing. Our vision remains strong: "To be disciples of Jesus Christ who are lifelong learners who influence others to serve." We have begun to dream together of how we might bring this vision to life in our conference, in our churches, and in our communities.
