




Join Us for Virtual Worship

Get Your Sewing Machines and Scissors Ready for the Next Project

Thank you all for your participation in the recent walker bag/tote bag mission project. Last November 40 tote backs packed with shampoo, conditioner, toothbrushes, toothpaste, lotion, hand sanitizer, tissues, notebooks, and pens were delivered to the H.E.R. shelter. In December, about 80 walker bags packed with socks, puzzle books, pencils, tissues, lotion, and hand sanitizer were delivered to underserved senior facilities in our community. The Red, White, and Blue themed fabric walker bags went to the Veterans Hospital nursing facility in Hampton. Thirty-two adult bibs were also being distributed with the walker bags and sugar free candy was also going out to each facility. Representatives from the receiving facilities have expressed extreme appreciation for these donations to their clients and residents.

Their next project will be to make pillowcases for the H.E.R. shelter and "hero" capes for EDMARC Children's Hospice and Red Bird Mission. We will meet on Friday & Saturday, February 11 & 12, 2022 beginning at 10 AM each day in room 13 at New Creation UMC. And as always, they need cutters and pressers too — not just folks who sew.

While there are all of the materials needed for the hero capes, they will need donations of cotton fabric to make pillowcases. One yard each of two coordinating 42- to 44-inch-wide fabrics will make 2 pillowcases. So, look through your stash for any suitable fabric you might have – in addition to the ladies at the shelter there are also young children as well as teenage children who reside there with their mothers so consider that when making fabric selections. They will also be accepting monetary donations to purchase fabric. If you've never made burrito pillowcases you are in for a treat. They are really fun and simple. So, get your machines tuned up and ready to go. Look forward to seeing you in February 2022.
